As of June 1, 2010, Bishop Galante has declared that St. Bridget Parish will serve as both a community parish and a personal parish to serve the needs of Rowan University in addition to territorial parishioners and the Latino community. Therefore we are a stand alone parish and no longer involved in a merger with other parishes.

Due to this decision, we are now in the midst of planning our own Religious Education Program under the direction of Sr. Janice Novak, the principal of St. Bridget Regional School prior to its merger with St. Catherine of Siena. Past catechists as well as several of the other Sisters have volunteered to assist in the program to bring the good news of the Catholic faith to our children.

PREP classes will take place at St. Michael the Archangel Regional School in Clayton on Tuesdays from 4:30 to 5:30 p.m.

If you have already registered in another PREP program, you are free to remain in that program. In the event that you choose to transfer to St. Bridget please let us know that your registration is a transfer.
