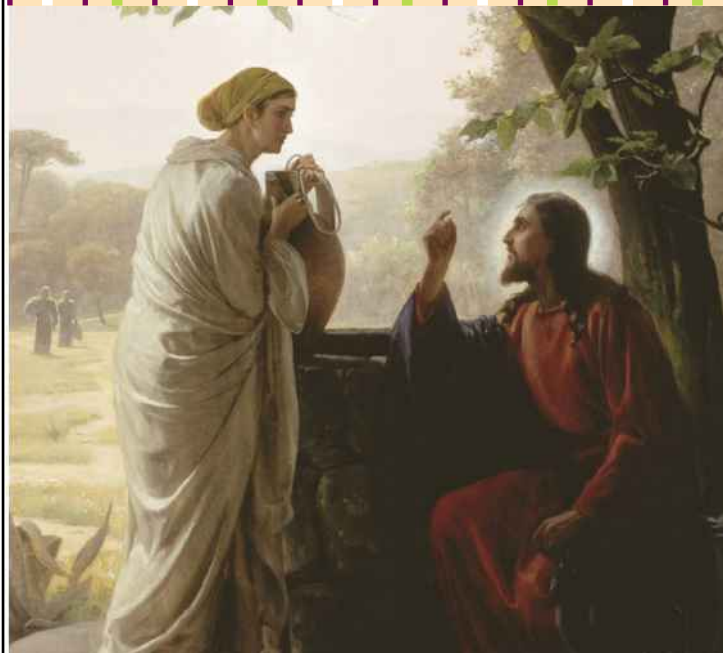

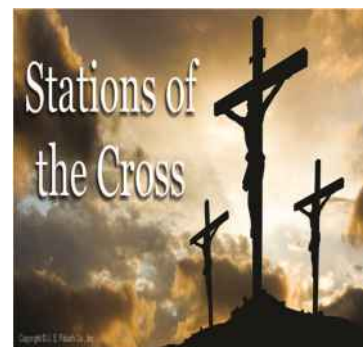

What is the Church's official position concerning penance and abstinence from meat during Lent?



In 1966 Pope Paul VI reorganized the Church's practice of public penance in his "Apostolic Constitution on Penance" (*Poenitemini*). The 1983 revision of the Code of Canon Law incorporated the changes made by Pope Paul. Not long after that, the U.S. bishops applied the canonical requirements to the practice of public penance in our country.

To sum up those requirements, Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. In addition, all Catholics 14 years old and older must abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent.

Fasting as explained by the U.S. bishops means partaking of only one full meal. Some food (not equaling another full meal) is permitted at breakfast and around midday or in the evening—depending on when a person chooses to eat the main or full meal.

Abstinence forbids the use of meat, but not of eggs, milk products or condiments made of animal fat.

Coronavirus Preparation

As the novel coronavirus (NCOVID19) continues to spread throughout the United States, we are learning more each day. The number of cases are rising along with associated deaths of the already immune-compromised patients. Citing numbers is futile as they are changing daily.

Dr. Rebecca Katz, director of the Center for Global Health Science and Security at Georgetown University states, “The most important recommendation is don’t panic, but prepare.” If the coronavirus spreads more widely in the US, having prepared for its arrival will benefit not just you, but also your loved ones, your neighbors, and people in your community. The CDC (Centers for Disease Control and Preparation) and the WHO (World Health Organization) recommend several basic measures to help prevent the spread of respiratory diseases such as Covid-19:

DO:

Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.

Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.

Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.

Stay home when you are sick; contact your health care provider immediately if you think you’ve been exposed to Covid-19. Fever, dry cough, fatigue, digestive issues, and nausea are the symptoms with fever always being present.

DON’T:

Touch your face, particularly your eyes, nose, or mouth as these are portals of entry for viruses.

Travel if you have a fever and cough.

Wear a face mask if you are well. Face masks should be used by people who show symptoms of Covid-19 to help prevent the spread of the disease to others. Per the CDC, you should only wear a mask if a healthcare professional recommends it.

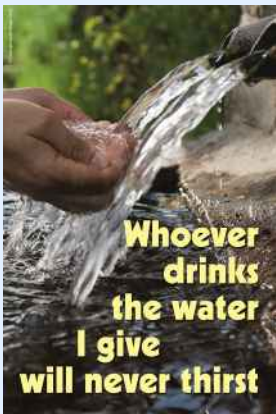
AVOID:

Shaking hands; hugs and kisses should be limited to healthy, immediate family members.

Going to the store if you are sick. Purchase a minimum of two weeks of food in advance, have a fever reducer along with a cough and cold remedy on hand.

If you are over 60 and have risk factors of cardio or respiratory disease, diabetes, hypertension, cancer or immune diseases, then you may consider social distancing. This refers to measures to reduce human contact, like canceling events, working from home, or ordering food rather than in-grocery store shopping. So far, children are either having mild cases or are not getting infected at all.

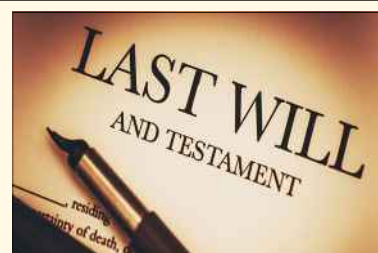
