**TWENTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

**L**iturgical turning point in  
**I** Luke's gospel: Toward the end of the  
**V** liturgical year—as our sequential reading  
**I** of a Synoptic gospel brings events closer  
**N** to Jerusalem and Jesus' passion and  
**G** death—we begin to pick up Parousia (referring to Jesus'  
 second coming) and eschatological themes. Often this  
 begins toward the end of October or early November and  
 culminates in the great eschatological festival, the  
**L** solemnity of Christ the King. This year, however, themes  
**I** that we would ordinarily be dealing with later in the  
**T** liturgical year already show up in late August. This is  
**U** because of the structure of Luke's gospel, about one-third  
**R** of which focuses on Jesus' journey to Jerusalem. The  
**G** prevailing journey theme is a reminder that our whole  
 Christian life is a journey to our final union with Jesus in  
 eschatological glory.

All of us receive a variety of "religious" articles in the mail. These may come in the form of holy cards, pamphlets, rosaries, medals, key chains, or greeting cards. Please do not leave these unwanted "religious" articles in the church. They are not blessed and so are not "holy" in that sense, and can either be tossed in the trash bin or sent back to the sender. Also, please do not respond to chain letters, nor leave them in the church. Chain letters are a form of superstition, and not a part of our Catholic tradition. Do not feel at all guilty about tossing unwanted "religious" articles, or discontinuing a chain letter.
