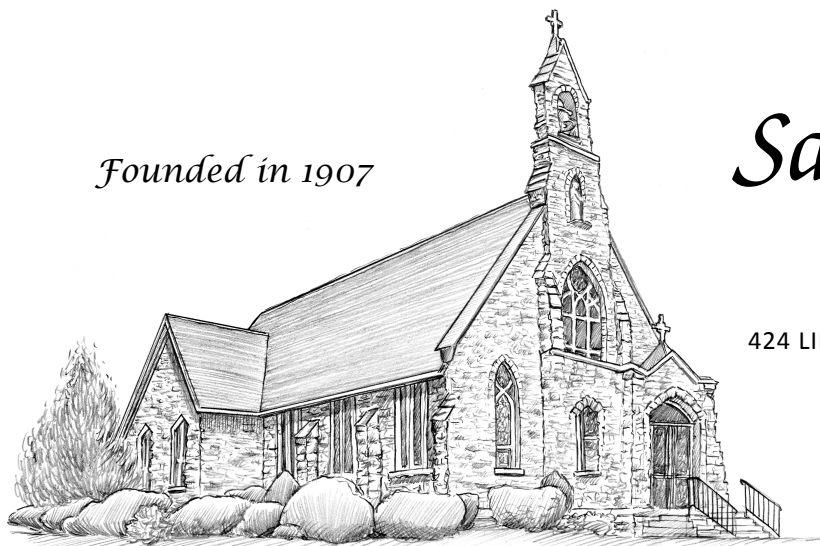

BAPTISM: Please contact the Rectory. The parents or a family member must be registered in the Parish Census. Sponsor Certificates of Eligibility with a Church Seal from his/her proper Parish are required before a Baptism date can be scheduled. Sponsors must be Catholic, at least 16 yrs. old, Confirmed, if married, Marriage recognized by the Catholic Church & regular in Mass participation. Our Baptismal Preparation Class is held on the 4th Monday of the month.

MARRIAGE: Please contact Rectory at least one year before the desired wedding date. **Never arrange a reception before the initial office interview.** The bride or groom or family member must be a registered parishioner at Saint Elizabeth's Parish.

MINISTRY TO THE SICK: Please report information to the rectory about parishioners in need of the Ministry.

PARISH REGISTRATION & CENSUS: Please be sure to register in the Parish Census & advise us of changes of address, phone, etc. Please be conscientious to use the weekly Stewardship Envelopes which are our means of knowing your weekly Mass participation for when you request a Certificate of Eligibility to be a Godparent or Sponsor.
