**October 26 / Tuesday:**

Private bus and English speaking escort to meet the group at the Rome FCO airport for transfer to the Rome StarHotel Michelangelo. Transfer time is 60 minutes. The 4-star hotel is located close to St. Peter Square in the heart of the baroque Rome. A stay at the Michelangelo is strategic for visiting St. Peter's Basilica and the Vatican Museums with the Sistine Chapel just a short distance away. A "must" within walking distance is the complex of Castel Sant'Angelo with its museum and the stroll along the Tiber embankment.

Afternoon free to walk around and rest. Bus and escort at disposal.

**October 27 / Wednesday:**

Breakfast at the Hotel.

Mass at St.Peters.

Private bus and English speaking guide for an afternoon tour of the Vatican museum to include the Sistine Chapel and St.Peters.

**October 28 / Thursday:**

Breakfast at the hotel.

Private bus and English speaking guide for morning tour of Ancient Rome. Walk the streets of ancient Rome where Emperors and Gladiators once ruled. Your itinerary begins at Capitoline Hill, home of Michelangelo's Renaissance piazza, and proceeds to the Roman Forum, where the ruins of this busy marketplace – temples, palaces, shops and the Senate – give you a glimpse into daily life of ancient Rome. Your tour finishes at Rome's most famous monument, the Coliseum in all its grandeur.

**October 30 / Saturday:**

Breakfast at the Hotel.

Private bus and English speaking escort for transfer to Assisi. Transfer time 2.5 hours. Check into the Hotel Cristallo. Of recent construction and with wonderful panoramic sight of Assisi, the Hotel Cristallo was planned and built with a technological and innovating criterion, it's easy to reach from all directions, thanks to its strategic position. **October 31 / Sunday:**

Breakfast at the hotel.

Private English speaking guide for morning tour of Assisi. The mystical city of Assisi is a beautiful medieval town based on Mount Subasio, overlooking a peaceful Umbrian landscape. On travelling down the winding, cobbled streets every corner astonishes one and all with quaint little shops. Assisi is essentially known for the fact that it's the place of birth of St. Francis in and that of Santa Chiara. Peace is the lifestyle in the city, a long-standing tradition started by St. Francis. Besides this, Assisi is also famous for the nearly destroyed frescos by the medieval painter Giotto in the Arena chapel.

The church of San Francesco - upper and lower - houses some of the most famous late Gothic paintings by artists such as Ambrogio and Pietro Lorenzetti, Simone Martini and Giotto.

Overnight at the Hotel Cristallo.

**November 1 / Monday:**

Private bus and English speaking driver from Assisi to Florence. Transfer time 2.5 hours. Check into the StarHotel Tuscany. The Starhotel Tuscany, located in the modern business area in the north of Florence, is just 3 Km from the highway and airport and a few minutes from the historical center to which it is connected by a free shuttle service.

This 4 stars hotel has just recently been fully renovated.

Its suggestive atmosphere is enlightened by a style that recalls the ancient Tuscan residences.

Afternoon free. The hotel has a shuttle into town. Bus and escort at disposal.

Mass in the early evening.

Dinner.

Overnight at the Hotel Tuscany.

**November 2 / Tuesday:**

Breakfast at the Hotel. Transfer into town to meet your private English speaking guide for full day tour of Florence. Stroll the streets of Florence and explore the highlights of this artistic city. The center of Florence will be the spectacular frame of a tour dedicated to the city's glorious past and also to its stimulating present life. Cross the famed Ponte Vecchio, lined with its many jewelry stores and admire the view from both sides of the bridge. Visit the statues lining the Piazza della Signoria and stroll the charming narrow medieval streets perhaps browsing in many of the fashionable boutiques. Cathedral Square with Brunelleschi's amazing Duomo takes you on to the Accademia where you can visit Michelangelo's most famous work, the David. Afternoon visit of the Uffizi. Visit one of the world's greatest art museums, the Uffizi Gallery and view works by Michelangelo, Raffaello, Leonardo da Vinci, Botticelli, Rembrandt and others. Outside in the Piazza della Signoria, Renaissance statues line the square.

Mass in the early evening.

Dinner.

Overnight at the Hotel Tuscany.

**November 3 / Wednesday:**

Breakfast at the Hotel. Tour to Tuscany with visits of Siena - San Gimignano and Chianti.

Day to Siena: Leave Florence at 9:00 am arrive in Siena at 10:30 am, visit Duomo, Piazza del Campo, Palazzo Pubblico, and Torre del Mangia. Leave Siena at 12:30 pm for San Gimignano, arrive at 1:30 pm, lunch and then visit Piazza del Duomo, Piazza della Cisterna, La Collegiata. Leave 4:30 pm for Florence with a stop in Chianti.

Dinner.

Overnight at the Hotel Tuscany.

Private bus and English speaking escort for early morning departure to Rome airport.
